# Using Eudora with Your Email

You can always use Web-Based Email to send and receive email messages. But you also can view your email with an email client. To access your email through Eudora®, add an account with the settings outlined below.

**Before You Start:**

You need the names of your incoming and outgoing servers to set up email with a client. Web-Based Email contains this information.

1. Log in to Web-Based Email at [email.secureserver.net](http://email.secureserver.net).
2. From the **Help** menu, select **Email Client Settings**.
3. Make a note of your incoming and outgoing server information.
4. Continue with the procedures outlined below to set up your email client.

**To Use Eudora® with Your Email**

1. In **Eudora**, either from the **Tools** menu, click **Options** (for Windows®) or from the **Special** menu, click **Settings** (for Mac®).
2. Click **Getting Started**, and complete the fields.
3. Check **Allow authentication**, and then click **OK**.
